Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly dry and chilly with broken cloud and some brighter spells. A little drizzle is possible over northwestern hills of Scotland where freshening southwesterly winds will bring slightly milder air. Overnight, dry and frosty across most areas with some mist or fog patches forming. But becoming milder and breezier over western Scotland with cloud and some drizzle.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Dry with broken cloud and bright spells in the south and east, but again cloudier and breezier over western Scotland with isolated drizzle. On Saturday, becoming milder in the northwest as southwesterly winds strengthen, but continuing dry and cold in south and east.
