#### General Situation

The United Kingdom will continue to lie in an unstable and showery airflow. As an area of high pressure develops to the north of Scotland, the flow will gradually veer easterly or northeasterly.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in the far northwest of the area, occasionally 2 to 3 in the southeast of the area generally increasing 5 to 7 tomorrow afternoon, perhaps occasionally gale 8 mid-channel later.

Smooth or slight in the far southeast of the area otherwise slight to moderate, increasing moderate to rough overnight.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, with hail and sleet at times risk of mist near the normandy coast overnight.

Good, locally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps occasionally gale 8 mid-channel until dawn, occasionally 3 to 4 in the southeast of the area.

Rather rough to rough in the northwest, slight to moderate in the southeast.

Rain or showers, locally heavy, with hail and sleet at times.

Good, locally moderate or poor.

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
