**Confidence:** High for a very windy Sunday then for more wet, windy weather to move in from west during Monday. Lower confidence for shower details on Tuesday and Wednesday.

**Headline for Sunday 07 Nov 2021:** Very windy. Showers, mostly north of area, wintry on the tops, dying out later. Bitterly cold.

### Forecast for Sunday 07 Nov 2021

**Weather:** Very windy with dangerous conditions at higher elevations due to sudden, storm force gusts of wind. Otherwise dry, bright in south of area but cloudier over eastern Cairngorms and Aberdeenshire hills with showers, wintry above 900m. Showers will die out later in the afternoon with winds easing down.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 50% in north of area, 80% in south.

**Visibility:** Very good generally with clouds well broken over Angus hills and Southeast Highlands about 700 to 800m. Occasionally poor as showers pass by in the north of area with clouds lowering to about 600m.

### Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Dangerous walking conditions, especially during the morning and early afternoon due to strong, gusty winds with risk of being blown over. Also feeling bitterly cold.

### Forecast for Monday 08 Nov 2021

**Weather:** Dry and bright morning. Thickening cloud with patchy light rain reaching Perthshire hills and extending to Angus hills during afternoon then ranges further north by evening. Strong winds returning to the tops.

**Maximum wind:** Strengthening southerly winds, average speeds of 30mph increasing 40 to 50mph in the afternoon with gusts 60 to 70mph by evening.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 80% decreasing 40% during afternoon and early evening.

**Visibility:** Very good during morning with clouds mostly above the summits. Becoming misty during afternoon, especially in southwest of area and poor visibility as rain sets in with extensive cloud cover forming about 500 to 600m

**Temperature:** **Glens:** 3 Celsius rising to 14 Celsius during afternoon.

**At 800m:** Plus 2 Celsius rising to plus 6 Celsius.

**Freezing level:** 1100m lifting above the summits during the morning.
