Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Tuesday 03 August to 1800 UTC Wednesday 04 August 2010

General Situation

Low pressure moving slowly eastwards to the north of Scotland and high pressure near the Azores will maintain a broad, showery westerly or northwesterly airflow across the United Kingdom. A small low pressure system running eastwards will bring more general rain or showers to the south later tonight and on Wednesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight, but moderate north and west of Orkney, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north, becoming cyclonic later.

Slight, but moderate north and west of Orkney, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Southwest veering west, 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 later.

Showers at first, then fair.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight, becoming mainly moderate.

Occasional drizzle, then rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Mainly moderate, occasionally rough in far southwest.

Showers at first, then fair.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

Occasional drizzle, then rain or showers.

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in north.

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.
Slight in south, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough later in north.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

General Situation

A low will remain slow moving near the Faeroes during tonight and Wednesday.

Southwest backing south 4 or 5.
Slight becoming slight to moderate.
Scattered showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 3 to 4, veering west 4 tonight, increasing 5 occasionally 6 late morning, veering northwest 4 to 5 late afternoon.

Slight becoming moderate, locally rather rough later.

Occasional drizzle tonight and at times tomorrow, with a risk of coastal fog patches.

Good, becoming moderate to very poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 to 5, perhaps 6 for a time, decreasing mainly 4 later.

Moderate, but rather rough in the south at first.

Any drizzle soon clearing to become fair.
