Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 05 October to 0600 UTC Tuesday 06 October 2020

General Situation

An area of low pressure currently centred over eastern England will drift slowly northeastwards into the North Sea through Monday and into Tuesday. This will bring unsettled conditions to all areas, with gales in southern waters.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming cyclonic later, 3 to 5, increasing 5 to 7 later near Orkney.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Orkney.

Showers, perhaps thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 to 7 near Orkney until later, otherwise variable 2 to 4, becoming west or northwest 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough until later near Orkney.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Moderate, occasionally slight later in Firth of Forth.

Showers, perhaps thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Northwest backing southwest, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, veering west 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 to 6.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in south.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in south.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 at times later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering westerly 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Rain then showers, perhaps thundery later.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 4 to 6 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly 3 or 4 at first in far east, otherwise westerly or northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough west of Lizard Point.
Rain then showers, perhaps thundery later.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough west of Lands End.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 to 7, backing west 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.

Rain then showers, perhaps thundery later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 to 6, veering northwest 5 to 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate in north, moderate or rough in south.

Rain then showers, perhaps thundery later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first in north.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest backing west, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in south.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5, veering northwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest backing west, 4 to 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain, showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Slight, becoming moderate.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 to 5, backing westerly 4 to 6 later, occasionally 7 later near Rathlin island.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly veering northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
- (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly northerly, 2 to 4, becoming southwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly, 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in Firth of Clyde, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, backing westerly 4 to 6 in south, occasionally 7 later near Mull of Kintyre.

Moderate or rough at first in west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, mainly in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 to 7 at first near Mull of Kintyre, otherwise northwesterly 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough later in west.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 to 4, occasionally 5 near Cape Wrath.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain in south, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast backing northwest, 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers, perhaps thundery later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 2 to 4, occasionally 5 near Cape Wrath.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain in south, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast backing northwest, 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough, occasionally very rough later in southwest.
Showers, perhaps thundery later in north.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure over NE England edges north through Monday bringing a strengthening easterly or southeasterly airstream across Shetland waters.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 5 to 7, locally 4 in the northeast of the area at first, occasionally gale 8 around midday, backing west to southwest this evening.
Rough to very rough, decreasing rather rough in the south and east of the area for a time this evening.
Rain, locally heavy, clearing to occasional showers this afternoon, heavy at times.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8 mid-channel, decreasing 5 to 6 later.
Rough, occasionally very rough mid-channel.
Occasional showers, heavy at times.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

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
