



## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

The combination of wintry showers drifting in from the North Sea and temperatures falling below freezing will lead to some icy patches forming. Some of these showers will fall as snow, more so inland where small accumulations are possible in a few places.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **17:00 on Fri, 05th Jan 2018** until **10:00 on Sat, 06th Jan 2018**

Icy patches are expected to develop during the evening and overnight, most likely on untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths. There is a chance that injuries could occur from slips and falls on icy surfaces.
