Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Showery outbreaks of rain, locally heavy and perhaps thundery, across
southeastern England will clear southwards this morning, then most
places should be dry with some sunshine. The best of the sunshine is
expected across western areas, but some northern and eastern facing
coasts may remain rather cloudy throughout the day. It will become
warm or very warm away from eastern coasts.

Tonight, most places will be dry, though some rain will spread to
western Scotland later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places will remain dry with bright or sunny intervals, though
some rain is likely at times in the north and northwest. It will
remain warm or very warm
