#### General Situation

Areas of low pressure and their associated weather fronts moving eastwards off the Atlantic will maintain the very unsettled spell of weather across the United Kingdom for the foreseeable future.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4, veering easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 towards Cape Wrath.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later in south.

Mainly good.

Occasional rain, mainly later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Isle of Man

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northeast, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain then showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northeast, becoming variable 3 or 4

later.

Smooth or slight south of skye, otherwise moderate.

Moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Mainly good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Low to the northeast of Shetland is drifting east, and slowly filling during Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

In the west: northwest 4 or 5, occasional 6 in the north.  
Mainly moderate, but rough in the north.  
Occasional rain, mainly north.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Jul until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03

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In the west: northwest 4 or 5, veering northeast 4.

Mainly moderate, but rough in the north at first.

Occasional rain in the north at first.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 4 by this evening.

Mainly moderate, locally rather rough in the north.

Occasional rain and drizzle.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain and drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 4 to 5, perhaps 6 in the north late morning.

Mainly moderate, occasionally rather rough in the north, with a low swell.

Occasional rain and drizzle, locally heavy Tuesday afternoon.

Moderate to poor in rain and drizzle, otherwise good.

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
