



## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Surface temperatures fell below freezing overnight and icy patches have formed, especially where further showers occurred during the early hours of today.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **06:30 on Sat, 06th Jan 2018** until **11:00 on Sat, 06th Jan 2018**

Icy patches are expected this morning, most likely on untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths. There is a chance that injuries could occur from slips and falls on icy surfaces.

This warning is being updated to extend the risk of ice through the mid morning.
