Forecast for Thursday 07 Mar 2024

Weather: Most ranges will be cloudy and there will be a few light showers. The showers will be mostly over the Angus and Perthshire hills and wintry on the tops. Some brighter interludes, best over eastern Cairngorms and Aberdeenshire hills.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 40%, best in north.

Low Cloud and visibility: Mostly good visibility beneath the cloud which will be extensive above about 700 to 800m. Cloud bases lifting a little during the morning with some breaks developing in north of area.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Combination of fresh or strong winds over higher ridges and summits and temperatures close to freezing will make it feel bitterly cold.

Forecast for Friday 08 Mar 2024

Weather: Mostly cloudy with sleet and snow showers, most frequent over Angus and Perthshire hills. Drier with some brighter interludes over eastern Cairngorms and Aberdeenshire hills.

Maximum wind: Strong east or southeasterly winds, average speeds of 25 to 30mph with gusts 45mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30%, best chance in north of area.

Low Cloud and visibility: Generally good visibility occasionally poor as wintry showers pass by. Also very poor in cloud which will be fairly extensive above about 700 to 800m with patches lower down as showers pass by.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 4 Celsius rising to plus 8 Celsius.
At 800m: Minus 2 Celsius.
Freezing level: 500m.
