Forecast for Saturday 06 Apr 2024

Weather: Storm Kathleen giving a very windy day with gales, severe at times over summits. Sunny spells developing during the morning, with some isolated showers. Showers becoming more organised with a spell of perhaps heavy rain later in the evening. Turning chilly in the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90%, lowering to 40% by the evening.

Low Cloud and visibility: Generally excellent visibility, with cloud mainly above summits. Cloud bases in showers lowering to 600m and visibilities reducing to moderate or poor.

Meteorologist's View

Gusts of 50-55mph mostly above 500m will give very difficult walking conditions with a significant risk of being blown over. Be prepared for sudden strong gusts on lee slopes. Temperatures dropping during the evening, with a significant wind chill developing at height. Note also the risk of heavier showers giving a soaking during the late evening.

Forecast for Sunday 07 Apr 2024

Weather: Strong and gusty winds continuing, with gales at higher elevations. Otherwise a mixture of sunny spells and showers, these heavy and perhaps thundery at times. Showers will tend to become lighter and less frequent during the afternoon, with mostly dry conditions by evening.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 30-40 mph, gusting 50-60 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 60% at first, soon becoming 90% during the morning.

Low Cloud and visibility: Areas of cloud above 500-600m at first, this lifting above the hilltops during the morning. However, cloud perhaps touching the higher summits in heavier showers. Visibility mostly good, but poor in heavier showers and very poor in any low cloud.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 5C becoming plus 12C during the afternoon.
At 600m: Plus 6C.
Freezing level: Above summits.
