#### General Situation

A large, slow-moving area of high pressure centred over the United Kingdom will bring settled conditions to most areas, although fog patches are likely at times with drizzle in the far north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak frontal trough affecting Shetland at first, with a ridge building behind later on Friday. Icelandic low extends another trough over Shetland on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5 occasionally 6 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight later in shelter east of Shetland.  
Mainly fair at first, rain or drizzle later.  
Mainly good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 03 Oct until 1800 UTC on Saturday

03 Oct:

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate but slight in shelter east of Shetland.

Rain or drizzle at first, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, further decreasing 1 to 3

Saturday morning and becoming locally variable.

Slight to moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly or variable 1 to 3, becoming southeast overnight, increasing 4 to 6 during the morning, perhaps 7 in the west of the area later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate and rather rough in the north of the area later.

Fair becoming cloudy in the afternoon with the likelihood of rain by evening.
