Forecast for Tuesday 08 Jun 2021

Weather: Much of the day cloudy, with hill fog and some patches of drizzle. Some breaks appearing later in the afternoon with increasing sunshine developing in the evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 10%, rising 30% in afternoon and 80% in evening

Visibility: Poor with hill fog cloud bases down to 400-600m lifting later with mainly good visibility.

Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Wednesday 09 Jun 2021

Weather: Mainly dry overnight but cloudy and some light rain from dawn. Rain becoming heavier by lunchtime and some quite heavy outbreaks are likely at times and possibly some thunder too. Rain clearing east during the evening but some patchy light rain may linger into the evening.

Maximum wind: Southwesterly 15-20 mph with gusts around 25mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 60%, areas of low cloud especially in the west around 600m will affect the fells.

Visibility: Visibility will be good initially but will become moderate at times as rain spread across the Lake District, falling poor in heavier outbreaks of rain.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 9 rising to 18 Celsius.
At 800m: Around plus 9 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
