Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A dull and damp day to come for most places, with outbreaks of drizzly rain and hill fog. A different story for Northern Ireland and western Scotland, as here it should be much drier and brighter with just one or two light showers. Those brighter conditions moving into western Wales and the far southwest of England later in the afternoon.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

The weather is set to remain changeable with spells of rain, though for most places the bulk of the rain should fall during the hours of darkness on both days. Temperatures will be about average, albeit breezy in the west.
