#### General Situation

High pressure will remain slow moving to the north of the United Kingdom with a complex area of low pressure to the south. This will maintain the fairly gentle northeasterly airflow across many areas during the next 48 hours.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Rattray Head.

Variable 3 or 4, but easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north until later.

Easterly or northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times in south.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure to north combining with a complex low across southern Scandinavia to keep a NE flow across the area.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east

Moderate, occasionally rough in east, but locally slight near southwest coasts of Shetland

Fair

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 06 Jun:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in east, but locally slight near southwest coasts of Shetland

Fair

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 4 to 5, occasionally 6, and gusty near showers, decreasing 3 to 5 late evening.

Slight to moderate.

Scattered showers, perhaps heavy, with a risk of thunder mist and a risk of fog patches.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 in the evening.

Slight occasionally moderate.

Isolated showers with a risk of thunder risk of mist patches especially later.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

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
