Forecast for Saturday 05 Feb 2022

Weather: A dry morning but cloud thickening from the west. Outbreaks of rain arriving in the afternoon, falling briefly as snow above 800m. Rain turning persistent and occasionally heavy from around mid afternoon and lasting for the rest of the day.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 80% overnight and during the morning but falling to 30% in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Mainly good overnight and morning with patchy fog on the tops. Cloud becoming persistent and extensive through the afternoon above 600m with patches on lower slopes. Below the cloud, good in the morning but often down to a few km in rain in the afternoon.

Meteorologist's View

Conditions deteriorating during the late morning and afternoon as winds strengthen and rain arrives. Gusts of 60mph across high summits and ridges above 700m.

Forecast for Sunday 06 Feb 2022

Weather: Mostly cloudy with further showery outbreaks of rain, heavy at first. Some bright spells for a time during the morning. Perhaps some sleet or snow above 800m but low confidence for this aspect of the forecast. Strong winds and severe wind chill at height.

Maximum wind: West or Northwest 30 to 40mph gusting 60mph, easing to 25 to 30mph gusting 40mph during the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 40%.

Low cloud and visibility: Frequent cloud above 600m. Occasionally very good between showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 7 or 8 Celsius, falling to Plus 2 Celsius in the evening.
At 600m: Plus 5 Celsius overnight, falling to Plus 2 Celsius in morning.
Freezing level: Just above summits.
