General Situation

A large area of high pressure will cover the United Kingdom over the next 2 days although a weakening cold front will edge southwards across northern areas on Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, but 5 to 7 in far north at first, veering northwesterly later.

Moderate or rough north and west of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle for a time later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, but mainly moderate north and west of Orkney.

Occasional rain or drizzle then mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches developing for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4 increasing 5 at times later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Northeasterly 3 or 4 in north and 5 or 6 in south.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north, 5 or 6 in south, occasionally 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in south later.

Mainly fair.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

Northeasterly 4 or 5 in west and 5 or 6 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

North or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 a times.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest 3 or 4.
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.
Slight in shelter, otherwise mainly moderate.
Occasional drizzle at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4 in south, 5 to 7 in north, veering northwesterly 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches at first, occasional rain or drizzle for a time later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 in southwest for a time.
Mainly slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4 in south, 5 to 7 in north, veering northwesterly 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough.
Fog patches at first, occasional rain or drizzle for a time later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 in southwest for a time.
Moderate but rough in west at first.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A weak front will cross Shetland and the surrounding waters on Friday, with a ridge then building from the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 03 Jun until 0000 UTC on Saturday

04 Jun:

Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.

Rain at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 to 5, locally 6 at times later.

Slight in the southeast of the area, otherwise moderate.

Fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 6, possibly 7 at times in mid-channel.

Slight to moderate in the southeast of the area, otherwise rather rough.

Fair risk of an isolated shower later Saturday.
