Forecast for Tuesday 09 Nov 2021

Weather: Dull and overcast day with occasional rain, mostly light and patchy, occasionally drizzly, at first, but also some heavier outbreaks chiefly between mid-morning and mid-afternoon. This clears east by early evening, with clear spells and only a few light scattered showers expected for the evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 10% or less increasing 80% from early evening.

Visibility: Becoming moderate or poor in rain and drizzle, very poor in hill fog with bases extensive from 450m for much of the day, before lifting and breaking late in the day.

Meteorologist's View

Hazardous conditions for much of the day with extensive hill fog coupled with rain.

Forecast for Wednesday 10 Nov 2021

Weather: A better day with a mix of sunshine and only a scattering of generally light showers.

Maximum wind: West to southwest 15mph or less.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Good becoming moderate in showers, also very poor fleetingly in hill fog as bases lower infrequently to 500m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 3 Celsius increasing 13 Celsius during the afternoon

At 800m: Plus 4 Celsius

Freezing level: Above all summits
