Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

High pressure persists over the south of the United Kingdom but a frontal trough will move south across Scotland and Northern Ireland. The high pressure will extend to Scotland and Northern Ireland later.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering westerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in north.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Slight or moderate, increasing rough or very rough in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Occasional mist and rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight occasionally moderate in north.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Slight.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Fair.

Good.

Slight.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or less.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or less.

Overnight mist patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in mist.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Overnight mist patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in mist.  
Smooth or slight.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest, 3 or less.  
Occasional drizzle later.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest, 3 or 4.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest 3 or 4 occasionally 5 this evening.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Mainly slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 at first near Lough Foyle.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight in south, moderate occasionally rough in north.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest, 3 or 4.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Good, occasionally moderate or poor.  
Mainly slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Rain or drizzle, then fair.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly veering northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north at first.  
Rain or drizzle, then fair.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

South veering northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Showers.

Good.

Rough or very rough.
