Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Friday 05 June to 0000 UTC Saturday 06 June 2020

General Situation

A showery northwesterly airflow will predominate at first. Thereafter, a deep area of low pressure forming over the northern North Sea during Friday will then drift southwards close to eastern coasts and will bring gales to many coasts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then rough or very rough in north and near Rattray Head.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Moderate or rough in east, rough or very rough in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic, mainly west or northwest, veering north later, 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then rough or very rough in north.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming north 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4, increasing 5 or 6, backing west 6 or 7 later.

Moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West becoming cyclonic, then north 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming northwest 5 or 6, backing west 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing southwest 6 to gale 8, becoming cyclonic, then north later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly veering northwesterly for a time, 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Showers, perhaps thundery for a time.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 to 7, backing southwesterly 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain or showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Becoming westerly or northwesterly 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 or 6, backing southwesterly 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, rain for a time.

Mainly good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough around headlands and in west.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight at times in eastern Bristol Channel, otherwise moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.
Slight or moderate becoming rough for a time.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate, occasionally rough later.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering northwest 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 6 to gale 8, veering northwest 5 or 6.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Rain or showers, becoming fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in east and rough or very rough in north.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 6 to gale 8, veering north or northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north, becoming slight or moderate in east.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough and very rough at times in

northern North Channel.
Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7.
Very rough at first in northern North Channel, otherwise moderate or rough,
becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 5 to 7, backing northwest 6 to gale 8 later.
Moderate becoming rough or very rough.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 6 to gale 8 veering north 5 to 7.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain then showers, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, then very rough in north and in
far southwest.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far north.
Showers, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.
Moderate becoming rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first in west.
Showers, fair later.
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Deepening low will move west across the North Sea towards Scotland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northwest veering northeast 5 or 6

Moderate becoming rough in west
Showers, rain later
Good, occasionally moderate later

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Saturday
06 Jun:

North or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later
Moderate or rough
Rain then showers
Good, occasionally moderate at first

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 5 to 6, perhaps locally 7 Friday evening.
Moderate to rather rough, with a low swell.
Widespread showers, becoming scattered Friday morning.
Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps poor at times overnight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 5 to 6, locally 7.
Moderate to rather rough, increasing rather rough to rough Saturday morning.
Scattered showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

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
