### Forecast for Tuesday 04 May 2021

**Weather:** Staying generally cloudy through much of Tuesday, with showers becoming more frequent and locally heavy after midday, and tending to merge to give some longer spells of rain through the afternoon and into the evening. Precipitation turning increasingly to sleet or snow down to 500-600m later in the day.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 40% becoming 70% by late morning, decreasing 30% by evening.

**Visibility:** Generally very good away from showers, but falling to moderate during rain showers and poor during any sleet or snow showers, with occasional cloud 400-500m.

### Meteorologist's View

Winds likely 10-15mph stronger than shown at 600m at times across highest peaks. Severe wind chill likely on peaks early in the day.

### Forecast for Wednesday 05 May 2021

**Weather:** More persistent rain, sleet, and snow clearing south through the early hours. Then a mainly dry start, but further showers developing by afternoon, these again possible heavy, and with some sleet or snow across the summits.

**Maximum wind:** NW 15 gust 20mph, but gust 25-30mph near any heavy showers.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 40%, becoming 90% during the morning.

**Visibility:** Occasionally moderate at first under patchy cloud around 500m, and in showers. Otherwise improving very good or excellent during the morning as cloud lifts off the hills.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 01 C becoming Plus 08 C  
**At 600m:** Minus 01 C becoming Plus 05 C  
**Freezing level:** Near 600m initially but rising above the summits during the morning
