Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 03 November to 1200 UTC Tuesday 04 November 2014

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will sink southeastwards, crossing the United Kingdom during this afternoon and tonight. This low will gradually move away southeastwards during Tuesday and Wednesday leaving a cool northerly airflow across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, increasing 6 or 7 later, occasionally gale 8 later in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north, decreasing 4 later in west.

Rough or very rough at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3, then northerly 4 or 5 later, occasionally 6 later in far north.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, but 4 at first in south.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming north or northeast 5 to 7.

Slight becoming moderate then rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers, thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming variable 2 or 3, then becoming north or northeast 4 or 5,

occasionally 6 later.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, but 6 or 7 at first near North Foreland,
decreasing 3 at times later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 becoming variable 2, then becoming northerly or
northeasterly 5 or 6 later.
Slight, becoming moderate later.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly, 5 to 7 at first in far east, otherwise 4 or 5,
increasing 6 at times.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 veering northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest 4 or 5, then veering north 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers then fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
West or southwest veering northwest, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing
4 at times later.
Very rough at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, veering north 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 to 7, veering north 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly veering northwesterly, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time in south.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest veering north 5 to 7, then veering northeast 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 5 to 7 becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then becoming north later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 5 to 7 becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then becoming north later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North veering northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in southeast, decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming northerly 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 or 6 veering northeast 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming cyclonic then northerly or northeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 becoming northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later in north, perhaps gale 8 later near Tiree.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near Tiree, veering northeast 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, then very rough later in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Very rough at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Rough or very rough becoming moderate.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Complex low, initially extending from northern Scotland to Northern Ireland,

moving south and east into the North Sea and Northern England by midday Tuesday, bringing gale force NE winds to your location.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8 expected later issued on Monday 3 November 2014 at 0344 UTC

Variable 2 or 3 becoming northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later in far northwest.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in far northwest.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov:

Northeasterly 4 or 5 in central and southeastern areas at first, otherwise 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 5 to 6, veering west to northwest by tomorrow morning decreasing 4 to 5, locally 6.

Moderate to rather rough.

Scattered showers with a risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 4 to 5, increasing 5 to 6 for a time by evening, veering northwest to north overnight.

Moderate to rather rough with a swell.

Scattered showers with a risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
