General Situation

A strong ridge of high pressure will maintain a very cold easterly or southeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom. However, winds should gradually decrease away from the south and far northwest.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, veering southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in east.

Mainly fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.
