

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Staying dull and wet across much of Scotland and Northern Ireland today, with further persistent rain. Elsewhere sees a mixture of sunny spells, with heavy and possibly thundery showers, making it feel cooler than yesterday. Rain continues overnight in the north, meanwhile elsewhere it turns mostly dry, with some patchy low cloud and isolated fog.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Cloud and outbreaks of rain will steadily clear northern areas tomorrow. Meanwhile southern parts will see a good deal of sunshine, with the isolated shower possible. Turning unsettled and cooler into Wednesday, with outbreaks of rain at times interspersed with sunshine and heavy, blustery showers.
