Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 03 June to 0000 UTC Tuesday 04 June 2019

#### General Situation

A large area of low pressure to the northwest of the British Isles will dominate the United Kingdom during Monday, before another area of low pressure moves across the United Kingdom during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly, 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough. Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough. Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time near Rattray Head. Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering east or southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate at first in north, otherwise slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, backing southeasterly 5 or 6 for a time.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far east, backing southerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Showers then mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, backing south later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering southwest, then veering northwest later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, backing south 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then west 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, backing southeast, then becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4, backing east or southeast 3 or 4, then veering south later.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, then north 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first, becoming mainly slight later.

Showers, thundery at first.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming northerly 5 or 6 for a time later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.  
Showers then rain.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South veering southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in northwest.  
Showers, thundery at first.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest becoming variable, 3 or 4, then north 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.  
Showers, rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, then decreasing 4 at times later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times in south and far north.  
Showers, thundery at first.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, but mainly rough in far north and at times in far south.  
Showers, rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, then decreasing 4 at times later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in south.  
Showers, thundery at first.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northeasterly 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers, rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Monday 03 Jun 2019 at 0000 UTC until Monday 03 Jun 2019 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A complex area of low pressure and associated troughs will remain close to Shetland Waters over the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Southeasterly veering southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south and east for a time

Moderate or rough

Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 03 Jun until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 04 Jun:

South 4 or 5 veering southwest 6 or 7

Moderate or rough

Occasional rain or showers

Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 to 4, occasionally 5 mid-channel at first, backing west to southwest by dawn, occasionally variable 1 to 3 from midday, backing south to southeast 2 to 4 during the evening.

Slight, perhaps moderate in the far northwest of area at first.

Mainly fine, risk of patchy light rain or drizzle in the far southeast at first risk of isolated showers after dawn, mainly in the west.

Good, perhaps moderate to poor in the far southeast at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 3 to 4, occasionally 2 in the east of the area at first, veering southerly 4, occasionally 5, by midday, veering southwest by midnight. Smooth to slight, perhaps locally moderate at times during the evening, with a low swell.

Showery rain spreading eastwards into the area from mid-morning, locally heavy and perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate from mid-morning.

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
