General Situation

Remaining unsettled with an area of low pressure over Scotland. Strong, perhaps gale winds, in the south.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers, some thundery, with fog patches mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Showers, some thundery.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Showers, some thundery.

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Showers, some thundery.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Squally showers.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Squally showers.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Squally showers.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7.
Squally showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Showers, squally at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Westerly to southwesterly 4 or 5, perhaps 6 at first in south,
veering northwesterly 5 or 6 later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.
Moderate, occasionally rough.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly veering northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east
later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde
and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4 becoming northwest 4 or 5.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
Variable, becoming northwesterly later, 2 or 3, occasionally 4.
Rain or showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles
24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5, backing northerly 2 or 3 later.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.
