for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 04 November to 1200 UTC Monday 05 November 2012

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure affecting the United Kingdom will maintain the cool unsettled weather. Gales or severe gales along English Channel coasts at first, gradually easing later this afternoon.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, backing northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in north.

Showers, then rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 2 or 3, backing northeast 3 or 4, backing northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west or southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast 2 or 3, becoming northeast 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, backing west later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first and later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing northeast 4 or 5, backing north 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain for a time in south, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, backing west or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, becoming northerly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, but moderate or rough at first in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly, backing westerly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times until later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or less later, then becoming northeasterly 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, backing northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, but 6 or 7 at first in east, veering northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 or 6, backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, but variable 4 at times in lyme bay, veering northeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Isles of Scilly, becoming rough or very rough for a time, except in lyme bay.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, but variable mainly southeast 3 or 4 in Bristol Channel, veering northeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in west.
Showers, squally at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 5 or 6, backing north or northwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.
Showers, then fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast, backing northeast later, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.
Showers, squally at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in south, backing
northwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, then mainly fair.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast, backing north or northeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast backing northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Mainly fair, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or southeast, backing north later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 4 or 5, backing west or northwest 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.
Occasional showers.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Southeast, backing north or northeast, backing northwest later, 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly backing northeasterly 4 or 5, backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in east.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing north later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast backing northeast, 3 or 4, backing north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest backing west, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, backing north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, backing west 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 04 Nov 2012 at 1200 UTC until Monday 05 Nov 2012 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak ridge of high pressure builds over Shetland for a time later Sunday. Front then follows by mid Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Easterly 2 or 3 backing north or northwest 3 or 4.
Rough at first in north and west otherwise slight or moderate.
Isolated showers.
Good, perhaps moderate at times.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Nov until 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Nov:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Showers increasing.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 6 with gusts to 35kt, veering west decreasing 4 to 5 overnight then 3 to 4 in the morning, further veering northeast increasing 5 to 6 in the north of the area by midday.
Rather rough to rough becoming moderate.
Scattered rain or hail showers, locally with thunder.
Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 6 with gusts to 35kt, locally west 3 to 4 in the south at first, backing north decreasing 4 to 5 in the evening, then northwest 3 to 4 Tuesday morning.
Moderate becoming rather rough to rough, then slight to moderate with swell on Tuesday.
Isolated showers at first.
Good.
