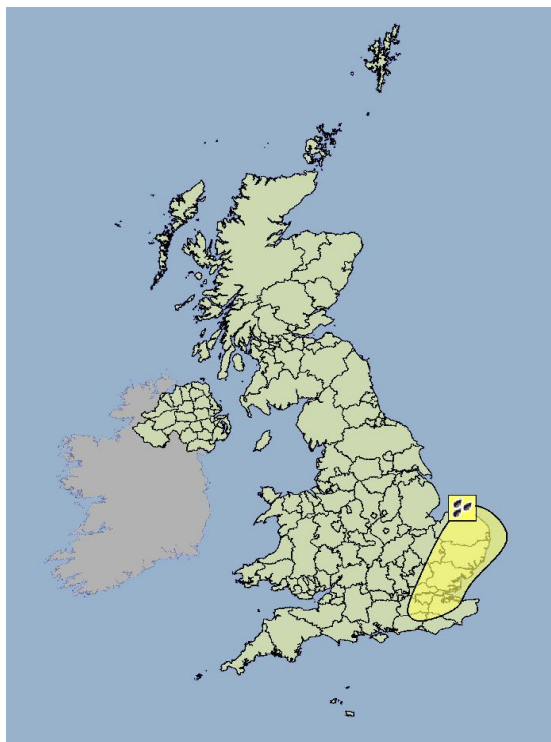




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Up to 30 mm could fall within a couple of hours locally, bringing the possibility of some travel disruption and surface water flooding.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **02:55 on Sun, 30th Jul 2017** until **06:00 on Sun, 30th Jul 2017**

Heavy, possibly thundery downpours have developed recently and may cause problems for travel through the rest of the night, and perhaps some localised surface water flooding, particularly in urban areas.

The downpours should clear to the east by or soon after dawn.
