Meteorologist's View

Expect significant wind chill at height

Forecast for Saturday 10 Apr 2021

Weather: Mostly dry in the morning with some good spells of sunshine. Somewhat cloudier in the afternoon with the chance of one or two snow or hail showers, but some places staying dry.

Maximum wind: Northerly 20 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 100%

Visibility: Generally excellent with great air clarity, occasionally dipping in any showers. Cloud expected to remain above summits

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 4 rising to plus 8 Celsius

At 800m: Minus 2 Celsius

Freezing level: 400 metres or less
