General Situation

An area of low pressure centred over northern England will move eastwards into the North Sea through the early hours. A brief ridge of high pressure will build across the United Kingdom through Sunday, before pressure falls again on Monday.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure covers Shetland and surrounding waters on Sunday, before deep Atlantic low extends troughs on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Variable, mainly easterly, 3 or 4.

Moderate, but slight in east.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 04 Sep until 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Sep:

Variable, mainly easterly, 3 or 4, veering southeast 5 or 6 later.

Moderate, but slight in east.

Fair.

Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6 at first, decreasing 2 to 3 early evening and backing southerly around midnight, veering southwest 3 to 4 by dawn.

Moderate to rather rough, decreasing slight by the evening.

Any drizzle and fog patches clearing this morning patchy rain or drizzle spreading from the west this evening with mist and fog patches.

Moderate to good, locally very poor at first, becoming generally moderate to very poor in the evening.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 4, occasionally 5, veering westerly by midday, becoming northwest in the south of the area in the afternoon and generally variable 1 to 3 after midnight.

Slight, with a low swell, locally moderate in the north at first.

Patchy light rain or drizzle in the morning mist or fog patches, slowly clearing.

Moderate to poor, locally very poor.

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
