Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

A slack pressure gradient affects the southeast of the United Kingdom with mist and fog on most coasts. Cold front affects the far west with rain at times.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly, 4 in far west, otherwise 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in east at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Fog patches, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north at first.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north at first, backing east 2 or 3 later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

East backing northeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, with daytime sea breezes.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, with daytime sea breezes in east.

Fog patches, occasional rain in west later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, later becoming northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far west.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, later becoming northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far west.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far west later.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly veering northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west later.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Rain and mist, perhaps fog patches.

Moderate or poor, perhaps very poor at times.

Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain and fog patches clearing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5, increasing 5 or 6 in North Channel later.

Occasional rain and fog patches clearing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, then veering northwest later.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Moderate or rough decreasing slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.
