Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0000 UTC to 0000 UTC

General Situation

An area of high pressure will become slow moving in the Atlantic to the west of Ireland and as a consequence there is a cool northerly or northeasterly airflow across the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, backing west or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Variable 3 or less becoming northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Showers then fair.

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in North Channel.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

North backing northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, occasionally 6 at first near Coll and Tiree.

Slight or moderate.

West or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, backing westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Cape Wrath.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first west of the Outer Hebrides, decreasing slight between barra and canna.

Showers, occasional rain in north later.

Good, occasionally moderate in north later.

West or northwest, backing southwest at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight at first between barra and canna.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

The Minch - (SWW)

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, backing westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain in north later.

West or northwest, backing southwest at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
