### Forecast for Friday 06 Oct 2023

**Weather:** Chance of a light shower across the west of the region at first. Otherwise largely dry with bright spells through daylight hours. Thickening cloud will bring rain from the west through the evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70% during the daytime, decreasing through the evening

**Low cloud and visibility:** Excellent visibility outside of cloud. Some patchy cloud above 700 metres, this becoming more extensive after dark across the north and west down to 500 metres.

## Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Winds will reach 70 mph or more across the higher tops at first with widespread upland gales. Winds will moderate by evening. Significant wind chill expected too. Making progress will be slow with a risk of being blown over.

## Forecast for Saturday 07 Oct 2023

**Weather:** Cloudy and rather cold throughout the day with persistent rain, this heavy at times especially in the southwest of the area. There's a chance that rain may turn to sleet and snow for a brief time. Rain may ease off through the evening.

**Maximum wind:** Easterly 20 mph with gusts to 30 mph on the tops

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70%

**Low cloud and visibility:** Poor in extensive areas of cloud down to 500 to 800 metres, some breaks possible towards the west coast

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 6 rising to 9 Celsius

**At 800m:** Plus 3 Celsius

**Freezing level:** Above summits, but may fall to 1100 metres for a time
