#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure to the west and northwest will push a series of fronts over the northern and western United Kingdom. Meanwhile high pressure will be slow moving to the south and east.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 or 5 veering southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in inner Moray Firth.

Occasional rain or drizzle fog patches in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or southwest 3 or 4 becoming west 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Occasional rain or drizzle fog patches at first in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in west.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

South 4 or 5 veering southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

South or southwest 4 or 5 becoming cyclonic 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic becoming westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in west.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.  
Rain or showers, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest veering north or northwest 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers, fog patches at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming cyclonic.

Slight or moderate  
Occasional rain, drizzle and mist

03 Aug:

Variable, mainly southwesterly 3 or 4

Slight or moderate

Occasional drizzle and mist

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming north 2 to 4 by midday, increasing 5 at times in the southeast of the area this afternoon, veering northeast 2 to 4 overnight.

Smooth or slight, perhaps occasionally moderate in the southeast of the area late afternoon and early evening.

Fine.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 2 to 4, backing northerly by midday, perhaps locally 5 in the southeast late afternoon.

Smooth or slight, perhaps locally moderate in the southeast of the area late afternoon and early evening, with a low swell.

Fair or fine.

Mainly good.

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
