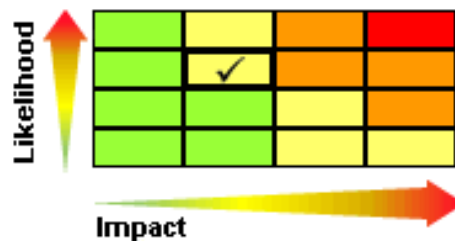
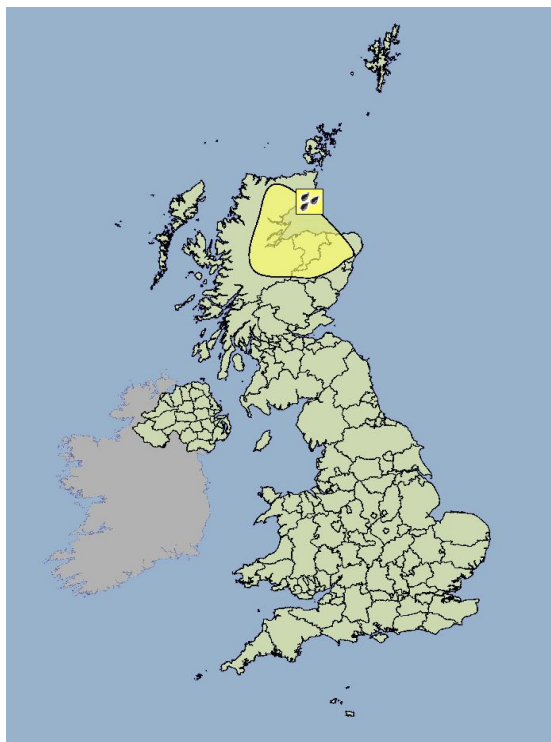




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Heavy showers and isolated thunderstorms will develop through the afternoon, before dying out slowly this evening. Although some places will remain dry, there is the potential for a few places to receive 20 mm of rain within an hour and very locally 30-40 mm in 2-3 hours.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **12:00 on Fri, 25th Aug 2017** until **21:00 on Fri, 25th Aug 2017**

Heavy, slow moving showers and isolated thunderstorms will develop during this afternoon, leading to the possibility of localised flooding and standing water on roads.
