General Situation

A complex area of low pressure affecting the United Kingdom will maintain the cool unsettled weather. Gales or severe gales through the dover straits at first, gradually easing this evening.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Mainly moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers, then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 2 or 3, backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west or southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers, then rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

North or northwest, backing west later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first and later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

Northeast 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate.

North or northwest, backing west or southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first and later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in at first south, becoming northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in south.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly, backing westerly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mainly good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east, veering northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly, backing northwesterly later, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 4 or 5.

Moderate, becoming mainly slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, backing northwest later, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, veering northeast later, 5 to 7, but variable 4 until later in lyme bay.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Lands End, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic mainly southwest, becoming north later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Lands End, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 to 7, backing northwest 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional showers.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast backing northeast, 5 to 7, backing north or northwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in south.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast, backing northwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers.
Good.

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast backing north, backing northwest later, 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

Northeast, backing north or northwest later, 4 or 5.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northwesterly 4 or 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Showers.
Good.

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 or 4, backing north or northwest 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.
Showers.
Good.

West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first in southeast.
Rain or showers.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak ridge of high pressure is building over Shetland for a short time. Front then follows by mid Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northeast backing northwest, 3 or 4 occasionally 5 later.
Rough at first in northwest otherwise slight or moderate.
Few showers at first then frequent showers or longer spells of rain.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Nov until 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Nov:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in east and later in west.
Slight or moderate increasing rough for a time in north and west.
Rain or showers, but mainly fair later.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 5 or 6 with gusts to 30kt, veering west to northwest around midnight and decreasing 4 or 5, further decreasing 3 or 4 during the morning, then veering northeast by midday and increasing 4 to 6.
Rather rough to rough, becoming moderate to rather rough Monday morning.
Scattered rain or hail showers, locally with thunder, dying out later Monday afternoon.
Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 or 6 with gusts to 35kt, backing northerly 4 by midnight, then northwest Tuesday afternoon.
Moderate to rather rough, becoming slight to moderate with swell on Tuesday.
Fair.
Good.

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
