Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 01 November to 1200 UTC Tuesday 02 November 2010

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure across the south and east will move away southeastwards later today. However a deep Atlantic low will track eastwards between Iceland and Scotland during tonight and Tuesday, bringing strong winds or gales to many coasts.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 or 6 increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering southwest. Slight or moderate in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, but becoming rough or very rough in far north later.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 at times in north. Moderate or rough, but very rough or high in far north.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering southwest. Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, veering west later, 6 to gale 8.  
Moderate or rough.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7, then veering southwest, perhaps gale 8 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.  
Moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.  
Moderate.

Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south, backing southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, then increasing 5 to 7.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east, backing westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time later in east.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4 backing west or southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate becoming rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough west of the Lizard peninsula.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate becoming rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.

Rough, becoming very rough in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, veering west later, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in south.

Occasional rain.

Moderate, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest veering west or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7, then veering southwest, increasing gale 8 at times later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, becoming moderate or poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 or 7, veering west 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 at times, perhaps severe gale 9 later in north.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, but becoming very rough or high in north.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, veering westerly later, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 at times.

Rough becoming moderate in south, very rough or high in north.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly veering southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times, perhaps severe gale 9 later in north.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, but becoming very rough near the Mull of Kintyre.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, veering westerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first. Mainly rough, but very rough in north.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 at first, increasing severe gale 9 at times later.

Moderate or rough becoming very rough or high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first.

Rough or very rough, becoming high at times.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 at first, increasing severe gale 9 at times later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough south of skye.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8.

Mainly rough, but very rough or high in far north and south.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 at first, increasing severe gale 9 at times later.

Moderate or rough becoming very rough or high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 at times.

Rough or very rough, becoming high, occasionally very high in west.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 01 Nov 2010 at 1200 UTC until Tuesday 02 Nov 2010 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep low will become slow moving near Iceland today as a trough crosses

Shetland tonight.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeast gale force 8

South 5 or 6, increasing 7 to severe gale 9.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 02 Nov until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Nov:  
South 7 to severe gale 9 veering southwest 6 to gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Rain then squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 2 to 4, backing west 4 by evening then southwest overnight and increasing 5 or 6, veering west for a time around dawn tomorrow.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rather rough locally rough.  
Rain or drizzle after midnight clearing during tomorrow morning.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor in rain or drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7 during Wednesday.  
Rather rough to rough.  
Rain or drizzle late Tuesday into Wednesday.  
Good becoming moderate or poor in rain or drizzle.

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
