Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

High pressure persists over the near Continent while a deepening low moves north to the west of the United Kingdom. The associated frontal trough affects western and northern areas on Saturday, extending to southeastern areas on Sunday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Showers, rain later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

South backing east or southeast 4 or 5.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in west.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4 backing southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 in west.

Fair then occasional rain.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7.

Fair then rain.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor in west.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7.

Showers then rain.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

Southerly 3 or 4, backing southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7.
