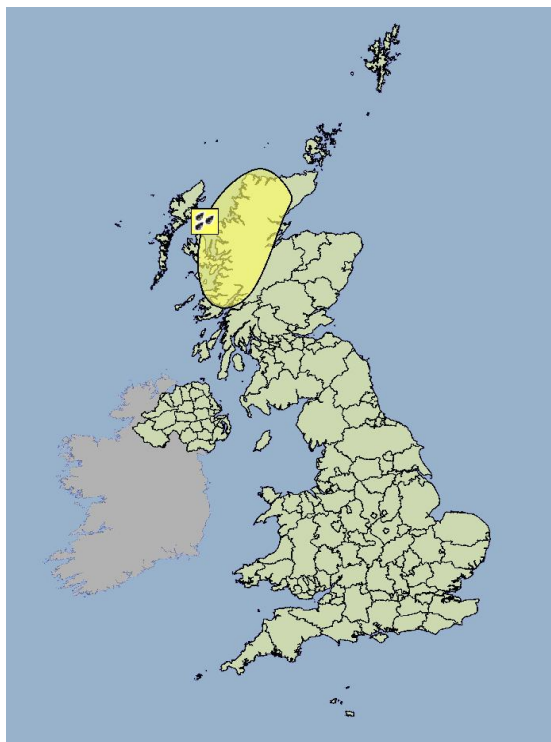




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A band of heavy rain will spread north across Scotland on Saturday. The rain will be most persistent in the northwest, where 30-40mm is likely quite widely. Where the heaviest downpours occur, there could be more than 60mm locally.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **13:00 on Sat, 27th May 2017** until **03:00 on Sun, 28th May 2017**

Rain will become persistent and heavy at times on Saturday afternoon and evening. Some torrential thundery outbreaks are likely in places, leading to some localised flooding, especially on the roads where some travel disruption may occur.
