#### General Situation

A strong ridge of high pressure will continue to extend southwestwards across the United Kingdom. Atlantic fronts will approach northwestern areas on Friday morning.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A ridge of high pressure continues to extend from Scandinavia over the North Sea to the British Isles. A frontal trough approaches Shetland from the west during Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

South or southwest 5, occasional 6.  
Moderate.  
Mainly fair, patchy rain.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Thursday 02 Feb until 1200 UTC on Thursday 02 Feb:

Southwest 5, decreasing 4.

Moderate, becoming rough in the west.

Occasional rain.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

Northeast to east 5 to 6, locally 7 at times.
