Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Tuesday 05 October to 0600 UTC Wednesday 06 October

#### General Situation

A deep Atlantic low 400 miles west of Scotland is expected to drift slowly northwards towards Iceland with a strong southwesterly flow affecting the north and west of the United Kingdom. Southern and eastern areas will be affected by a waving cold front with a couple of small areas of low pressure moving northeast across southeast England today and Wednesday. A ridge of high pressure will develop in southeastern areas on Thursday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in north.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in north.

Showers then fair.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north and slight in south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north and slight in south.

Showers then fair.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

South 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers, but mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic for a time, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain, fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Cyclonic becoming south or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain, fair later.  
Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming mainly good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Cyclonic becoming south or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Moderate or rough.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough in west, and very rough or high in far west.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate in east, rough or very rough in west, but very rough or high in far west at first.  
Showers, fair later.  
Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in west, but becoming very rough or high in far southwest.  
Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in west, but very rough or high in far southwest at first.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing mainly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5.

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, but rough or very rough in north.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

South or southwest 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5.  
Moderate or rough.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 6 to gale 8.  
Moderate with shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, occasionally high in west.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 6 to gale 8 decreasing 5 or 6.  
Moderate with shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, occasionally high in west at first.  
Showers.  
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high south of skye.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough north of skye, very rough or high to the south.  
Showers, squally at first.  
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west.  
Very rough or high, occasionally very high in far west for a time.  
Squally showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.  
Very rough or high.  
Showers, squally at first.  
Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A broad south to southeasterly flow covers Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeasterly gale force 8 at time of issue

South or southeast 6 or 7.  
Rough or very rough.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 05 Oct until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 06 Oct:

South or southeast 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 in west.  
Rough or very rough.  
Scattered showers.  
Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 4 to 5, veering southwest to west 3 to 4 early this afternoon, backing south this evening, increasing 4 to 5 overnight.  
Moderate, locally rather rough in mid channel at first and overnight.  
Outbreaks of rain and drizzle, clearing this afternoon, but returning towards midnight.  
Moderate to poor in rain and drizzle, otherwise good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 to 5, veering west Wednesday afternoon, backing south to southeast overnight.  
Slight to moderate with a swell.  
Rain and drizzle clearing by mid-morning.  
Moderate to poor in rain, becoming good.

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
