Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 05 October to 0000 UTC Tuesday 06 October 2020

General Situation

A deep and complex low currently centred over eastern England will drift slowly northeastwards into the North Sea through Monday and into Tuesday. This will bring unsettled conditions to all areas, with gales in southern waters.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later near Orkney.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 to 6 near north Orkney, otherwise northeast 3 or 4, backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Orkney.

Showers, perhaps thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, backing northwesterly later in south, 3 to 5.

Moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly, backing westerly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Moderate, occasionally slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, becoming west or northwest later, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight later in south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 2 to 4, increasing 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming westerly or northwesterly 3 to 5, then backing southwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 south of Flamborough Head.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less at first in far northwest, otherwise cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in east, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 7 or gale 8 at first in far east, otherwise westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6, increasing 7 for a time later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far south.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly, backing southwesterly later, 4 to 6, increasing 7 for a time later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers, fair for a time.

Moderate, becoming good for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5 at first in east, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far west.

Rough or very rough at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough in far southwest.
Showers, occasionally thundery.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far southwest, decreasing 4 at times in north.

Rough or very rough at first south of lundy, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, backing west 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far south.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 to 6, increasing 7 at times.

Slight or moderate at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain at first in north, otherwise showers.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, backing west later, 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest backing west, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 6.

Moderate.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Lough Foyle and Carlingford Lough, backing west 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first west of Rathlin Island.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in far northwest.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in far northwest.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly northerly or northwesterly, 2 to 4, becoming westerly 4 or 5 later in south.
Slight or moderate in North Channel, otherwise smooth or slight.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly 4 to 6 in south, otherwise variable 3 or less becoming westerly 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in Firth of Clyde, becoming moderate or rough later.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming west 3 to 5 later near Mull of Kintyre.
Moderate or rough at first in west, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly 4 to 6 near Mull of Kintyre, otherwise variable 3 or less becoming northwesterly 4 to 6.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in west.
Rain or showers, mainly in south.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast 4 or 5, backing east 2 to 4.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.
Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest 3 to 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in far southwest.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, backing east 2 to 4.
Moderate or rough, becoming moderate.
Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest 3 to 5 later.
Moderate, occasionally slight, becoming rough or very rough later in southwest.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure over NE England edges north through Monday maintaining the easterly or southeasterly airstream across Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

East veering southeast 3 or 4

Mainly moderate

Rain in west soon clearing then mainly fair

Moderate or poor at first in west, otherwise good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Oct until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 06 Oct:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first

Mainly moderate

Isolated showers

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to west 5 to 7, locally gale 8 until mid-afternoon, backing west to southwest in the evening.

Rough to very rough.

Rain, locally heavy, clearing to occasional showers in the afternoon.

Moderate or good, locally poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 to 7, perhaps occasionally gale 8 mid-channel.

Rather rough to rough.

Occasional showers, some heavy.

Moderate or good, locally poor at times.

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
