Forecast for Friday 02 Jul 2021

Weather: Some areas of low cloud in the east around dawn, lifting and breaking during the morning. Fewer clouds in the west but a risk of mist and shallow fog in prone valleys. Dry with sunny spells developing otherwise but a risk of showers in the afternoon, perhaps with the odd heavy one later. Any showers will die away during the evening, with clear skies returning.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 30% in the east but 80% in the west at dawn, then becoming 95% or more for all areas by noon.

Visibility: Mediocre initially, either in cloud with cloud bases around 200-400m early morning or in valleys, with mist and shallow fog. Improving through the morning to become good or even very good, with distant hills clearly visible.

Forecast for Saturday 03 Jul 2021

Weather: Unsettled and rather cloudy with showers, heavy with a risk of hail and thunder in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Southerly 10mph with gusts 15-20mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: Generally 50-70% throughout the day.

Visibility: Mediocre early morning, with areas of low cloud around 200-300m. Good otherwise, but locally poor in and around any showers, with cloud down to 600m at times.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 14 becoming plus 22 Celsius
At 600m: Plus 11 becoming plus 14 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
