### Forecast for Sunday 07 Jan 2024

**Weather:** Chance of a few mist and fog patches during the morning. Mostly staying dry with the best of the weak winter sunshine expected across southern and western ranges during the morning. Otherwise, widely cloudy. Slight chance that a few light showers may reach the east of the park late on, perhaps falling as snow above around 400-500m.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 90% in south and west, 70% in east.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Early mist and fog patches are possible, particularly in western valleys, this lifting and clear by mid-morning. Transient cloud may shroud highest summits at times, mainly in the east. Otherwise, bases are expected to remain above tops. Visibility generally very good, but very poor in any early fog. Visibility may briefly deteriorate to poor in any isolated snow showers.

### Forecast for Monday 08 Jan 2024

**Weather:** Variable cloud with bright or sunny spells at times, particularly across western areas. Some patches of mist and valley fog, or freezing fog may form in the early hours if clear skies persist. This is expected to clear by mid-morning. A few isolated showers may reach the east of the park later, falling as snow above around 300m, otherwise widely dry. Strong and gusty winds leading to a high risk of severe wind chill at higher elevations.

**Maximum wind:** East or Northeast 20-30mph, gusting 30-40mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m:** 90% in west and 80% in east.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Visibility very good, very poor in any early fog or freezing fog patches and briefly becoming poor or very poor in wintry showers. Cloud bases occasionally lowering to 600m in east, infrequently so in west.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Minus 1 Celsius increasing 4 Celsius during the afternoon

**At 600m:** Minus 5 Celsius

**Freezing level:** 400m, lowering to 200m.
