General Situation

Low pressure will move in from the west with various associated frontal systems running across the United Kingdom over the next couple of days bringing unsettled weather.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Rattray Head.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate or rough, but slight in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain or showers.

Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in west.

South or southeast, veering southwest later 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 west of lundy.
Moderate or rough, but slight in Bristol Channel.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Moderate or rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

South or southeast, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.
Moderate or rough.

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, but becoming cyclonic 3 or 4 in north.

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at times, becoming cyclonic or
northwest 3 or less later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain at times.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North
Channel - (SWW)

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure that covers Shetland at first, will decline as a frontal trough moves from the south on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Southwest becoming variable 3 or 4, then east or southeast 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough occasionally very rough at first in west.

Mainly fair, rain or drizzle later.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 03 Apr until 1800 UTC on Sunday 03 Apr:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 for a time in west.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or drizzle perhaps mist at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South to southeast 3 to 5, perhaps locally 6, increasing 5 to 6 Sunday afternoon, occasionally 4.

Smooth or slight, perhaps occasionally moderate mid channel.

Cloudy with the risk of showers, becoming scattered showers by midday.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 5 to 6, perhaps locally 7 in the north, veering south to southwest by dawn and decreasing 4 to 5 by midday.

Slight in the south to moderate in the north with a low swell, locally rather rough mid channel from early morning.

Isolated showers.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

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
