General Situation

Weakening Atlantic weather fronts will continue to edge southeastwards across England, becoming slow-moving across the southeast tonight and early on Tuesday. Despite this pressure will be generally high bringing mainly settled weather conditions to the United Kingdom.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first near Cape Wrath, becoming variable 3 or 4 elsewhere.

In north, rough or very rough becoming moderate, but slight in south.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5 near aberdeenshire and Cape Wrath, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Moderate in north, slight in south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest veering northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming east 3 or 4.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but mainly northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near headlands.

Rough until later near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate in west, slight in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near headlands in west.

Moderate west of Lizard Point, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate near headlands.

Fair.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough near land's end, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first in south.

Variable mainly easterly 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate in west, slight in east.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Slow moving low north of Iceland extends troughs towards Shetland while high pressure builds to the south by Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north and west.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in west.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, perhaps moderate at times.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north and west, backing southerly 4 later in southwest.

Moderate or rough becoming slight in lee of east Shetland.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 2 to 3, locally 4 at first, veering northerly towards midnight, then northeast by dawn, increasing 3 to 4 during the afternoon.

Slight.

Occasional light rain or drizzle with a risk of fog patches, clearing by dawn.

Moderate to very poor becoming good by dawn.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 3 to 4.

Slight with swell.

Fair.
