General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will move east across the United Kingdom during Monday to be followed by a weakening trough of low pressure moving southeastwards during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

West backing south for a time, 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate north and west of Orkney.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West, backing southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in Moray Firth.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

West 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southwest backing south 3 or 4, veering west 4 or 5 later.
Slight becoming moderate.
Showers, occasional rain or drizzle for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

West or southwest 4 or 5.
Moderate, occasionally rough in west later.

The Minch

General Situation
A weak ridge of high pressure topples across Shetland waters today ahead of a weakening frontal trough.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 03 Aug until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 03 Aug:

Southwesterly 3 or 4 backing southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.
Slight or moderate.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, backing west for a time this evening, then generally backing west to southwest by midday tomorrow.
