Forecast valid from 00:00 on Saturday 10 Sep 2022 until 23:59 on Sunday 11 Sep 2022

Forecast Issued on Friday 09 Sep 2022 at 16:25

Confidence: High confidence for the weather becoming more settled this weekend, and a change to more unsettled conditions again early next week. Lower confidence though regarding rainfall details during the early to middle part of next week, with the potential for it to turn warm and humid for a while, and with fresher, but more settled weather gradually expected to arrive from the northwest.

Headline for Saturday 10 Sep 2022: Cloudy at first with some mist or fog patches, although mainly dry. Brightening up, but with the chance of a few showers developing. Clearer spells into the evening.

Forecast for Saturday 10 Sep 2022

Weather: Mostly cloudy at first with the chance of some mist or fog patches, although generally dry. Cloud lifting and breaking during the morning to give some sunny intervals, although a chance of a shower breaking out, particularly late morning and for a time during the afternoon. Fine heading into the evening with late sunshine followed by clear spells after dusk.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 30% or less at first, rising to around 50% by mid morning, then rising above 80% away from any showers for the afternoon and evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Moderate or poor at first in mist or fog patches, but improving to become very good or excellent away from any showers for the afternoon and evening. Dropping back to moderate should showers form.

Meteorologist's View

Although it is likely to feel pleasant in any afternoon sunshine in the valleys, temperatures will remain on the cool side near to the hill tops, so some warm clothing is still advised.

Forecast for Sunday 11 Sep 2022

Weather: Dry during the day with patchy cloud and any early mist lifting to allow some sunny spells to develop. Feeling warm. Cloud then thickening from the west during the evening with some patchy drizzle possible towards midnight, and turning misty again near the hill tops as the cloud base starts to lower, particularly on west facing upslopes.

Maximum wind: East or southeast 8 to 12mph, with gusts 15mph, turning south to southeasterly for the afternoon and evening and increasing 12 to 17mph, with gusts to around 25mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Less than 60% at first, increasing to 90% or more during the morning, then lowering to 40% or less through the evening, particularly towards the west of the region.

Low cloud and visibility: Moderate in early mist patches, then becoming very good, before dropping to moderate near to some of the hill tops later in the evening.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 12 Celsius, rising to Plus 21 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 9 Celsius, rising to Plus 16 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits throughout.
