Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Saturday 05 June to 0600 UTC Sunday 06 June 2021

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will dominate the United Kingdom during the weekend, although weakening Atlantic fronts will move into some western areas at times.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

##### 24 hour forecast:

Southeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head, veering west or southwest 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate to the north and west of Orkney.

Fair then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest, becoming variable, then southeast later, 2 to 4, increasing 5 at times.

Moderate west and north of Orkney, otherwise smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

##### 24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing southeasterly for a time, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time in south.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly in north, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southeasterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

##### 24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 for a time, then becoming northwest later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain later, otherwise mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest veering east or southeast, 2 to 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

##### 24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 3 or 4, then veering northwest later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North or northwest, veering east or northeast, 2 to 4.  
Smooth, occasionally slight.  
Fog patches later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland  
24 hour forecast:  
Northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth, occasionally slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 2 to 4, backing westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or southwesterly, becoming variable later, 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, fog patches developing.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain later in west, otherwise mainly fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, fog patches developing.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 to 4 at first in far east, otherwise southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west, veering northeasterly later near the Isles of Scilly.  
Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.  
Fair then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches developing.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Mainly moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches, becoming mainly fair later.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 until later in west, otherwise variable 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate at times in west.  
Fair, then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches developing.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in southwest.

Occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, veering southwest, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate for a time near St Davids Head.

Fair then occasional rain or drizzle with fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, with fog patches at times, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 until later in north and west, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South, veering north or northwest later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 to 5, veering northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4 later.  
Slight or moderate in northwest, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Showers, fog patches for a time in east.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly, becoming variable, 2 to 4.  
Slight or moderate in northwest, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly, 3 to 5, veering westerly or northwesterly 2 or 3.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.  
Mainly fair, then showers with fog patches developing for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwesterly becoming variable, 2 to 4.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near Mull of Kintyre.  
Fair.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 3 to 5, veering west or southwest 2 to 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

The Minch  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast veering southwest, 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 3 to 5, backing south or southeast 2 to 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in south.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast veering southwest, 3 to 5.  
Moderate, occasionally slight near Cape Wrath.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 3 to 5, backing south or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Saturday 05 Jun 2021 at 0600 UTC until Saturday 05 Jun 2021 at 1800 UTC

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia will maintain a slack, settled airflow over Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

East or southeast 2 or 3  
Slight or moderate  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Sunday 06 Jun:

Southeast veering southwest 2 or 3  
Slight or moderate  
Fog patches, showers later  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

#### Channel Islands

##### 24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 3, locally variable 1 or 2 from midday.  
Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell developing.  
Occasional rain or drizzle and mist or fog patches, mainly in the north and west of the area after midnight.  
Good, becoming locally moderate to very poor later.

##### Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south of the area, becoming generally variable by evening.  
Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, clearing in the evening mist or fog patches.  
Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor.

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
