### Forecast for Wednesday 06 Jul 2022

**Weather:** Very windy and gusty conditions at height. Cloudy with outbreaks of mostly light rain but heavier for time in the morning towards Creag Meagaidh. Rain fizzling out through the afternoon but remaining cloudy.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** Almost zero chance on west, 30% in east.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Extensive low cloud and fog down to low slopes in the west and above about 600m in the Cairngorms. Cloud bases lifting a little through the afternoon but most tops remaining in the fog.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

Gusts of 60 to 70mph on high ridges and summits bring a significant risk of being blown over. Sudden gusts also possible on lee slopes. Conditions easing from late afternoon.

**Forecast for Thursday 07 Jul 2022**

**Weather:** A rather cloudy start but brightening up with increasing sunshine through the morning. Clouding over from the west again during the afternoon with some patchy light rain but clearing up again in the evening. Feeling warm at low levels.

**Maximum wind:** Northwesterly 25mph gusts 35mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m:** 70% becoming 30% in afternoon, improving in evening.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Patchy cloud and fog above 500m at first but lifting and breaking with good visibility across all ranges in the morning. Cloud and fog becoming extensive again in the afternoon above 600m but lifting and breaking in evening.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 12C rising to 19C.  
**At 800m:** Plus 8C rising to 13C.  
**Freezing level:** Well above summits.
